**WHEREAS**, this event is being held to bring all the nationalities and citizens of Weirton together to learn about the diversity of the City of Weirton; and

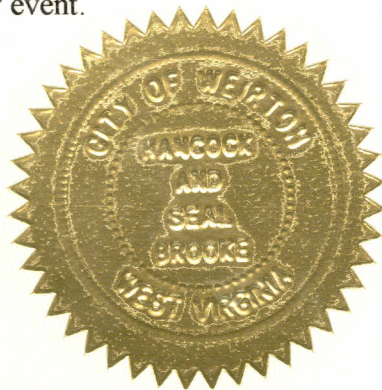
**WHEREAS**, we recognize the value of such programs which strengthen the spirit of solidarity and cooperation between our communities nationalities; and
